The aims and objectives of the club will be:

- To offer coaching and competitive opportunities in cricket for all its members.
- To promote the club and cricket within the local community.
- To ensure a duty of care to all members of the club by adopting and implementing the ECB "Safe Hands-Welfare of young people in cricket" policy and any future versions of the policy.
- To provide all its services in a way that is fair to everyone
- To ensure that all the present and future members receive fair and equal treatment.

Activity details:

- **Coaching nights** for Kwik cricketers, U9, 11, 13 and 15's are held on Wednesdays. They usually start last week in April and run for 10 weeks. Fee's are payable in advance for the whole 10 week course. They are reviewed annually.
- **Coaching Session times** are 18:30 to 20:00 for the Kwik cricket groups and 18:30 to 20:30 for all other age groups.
- **Equipment required**-suitable clothes preferably white and trainers of course. The club provides all the necessary cricket kit for both coaching sessions and competitions. We encourage parents/children to buy their own personal protection equipment e.g. box and helmet for the obvious hygiene reasons as soon as they start "hard" ball cricket.
- **Competitive games** are arranged in the summer for U11, U13 and U15 age groups. We play in the newly formed Salisbury & District Junior League. U11's are Sunday mornings, U13's play on Thursday evenings and 15's usually Tuesday evenings. In the winter the club runs U10, 12, 14 and 16 teams indoors on a Sunday afternoon at Castledown Sports Hall. Run by SADICA.

Player development

- The club has **links to South Wilts CC** in Salisbury which is a development pathway available for the more gifted players.
- The club recommends its more gifted players for both district and county team trials along with any Local Authority coaching initiatives.
